We must constantly remind individuals that we need to be notified of changes of address or facilities. If we get returned mail (about 20 each month), we remove that individual from the files. If you have, or you are going to be moved, please drop us a note to keep your file active. We get mail returned for bad ID #'s, no cell #, and no bed #. Make sure that your return address is inside the envelope as well as on the envelope – we get many damaged envelopes that are unreadable.

The USA Tax System Explained in Beer

Suppose that every day, ten men go out for beer and the bill for all ten comes to \$100. If they paid their bill the way we pay our taxes, it would go something like this:

The first four men (the poorest) would pay nothing.
The fifth would pay \$1.
The sixth would pay \$3.
The seventh would pay \$7.
The eighth would pay \$12.
The ninth would pay \$18.
The tenth man (the richest) would pay \$59.

So, that's what they decided to do.

The ten men drank in the bar every day and seemed quite happy with the arrangement, until one day, the owner threw them a curve ball.

"Since you are all such good customers," he said, "I'm going to reduce the cost of your daily beer by \$20". Drinks for the ten men would now cost just \$80.

The group still wanted to pay their bill the way we pay our taxes.

So the first four men were unaffected.

They would still drink for free. But what about the other six men? The paying customers?

How could they divide the \$20 windfall so that everyone would get his fair share?

They realized that \$20 divided by six is \$3.33. But if they subtracted that from everybody's share, then the fifth man and the sixth man would each end up being paid to drink his beer.

So, the bar owner suggested that it would be fair to reduce each man's bill by a higher percentage the poorer he was, to follow the principle of the tax system

they had been using, and he proceeded to work out the amounts he suggested that each should now pay.

And so the fifth man, like the first four, now paid nothing (100% saving).

The sixth now paid \$2 instead of \$3 (33% saving).

The seventh now paid \$5 instead of \$7 (28% saving).

The eighth now paid \$9 instead of \$12 (25% saving).

The ninth now paid \$14 instead of \$18 (22% saving).

The tenth now paid \$49 instead of \$59 (16% saving).

Each of the six was better off than before. And the first four continued to drink for free. But, once outside the bar, the men began to compare their savings.

"I only got a dollar out of the \$20 saving," declared the sixth man.

He pointed to the tenth man, "but he got \$10!"

"Yeah, that's right," exclaimed the fifth man. "I only saved a dollar too. It's unfair that he got ten times more benefit than me!"

"That's true!" shouted the seventh man. "Why should he get \$10 back, when I got only \$2? The wealthy get all the breaks!"

"Wait a minute," yelled the first four men in unison, "we didn't get anything at all. This new tax system exploits the poor!"

The nine men surrounded the tenth and beat him up.

The next night the tenth man didn't show up for drinks, so the nine sat down and had their beers without him. But when it came time to pay the bill, they discovered something important.

They didn't have enough money between all of them for even half of the bill!

And that, boys and girls, journalists and government ministers, is how our tax system works.

The people who already pay the highest taxes will naturally get the most benefit from a tax reduction.

Tax them too much, attack them for being wealthy, and they just may not show up anymore.

In fact, they might start drinking overseas, where the atmosphere is somewhat friendlier."

TONY'S STORY

In my brother's final weeks, days and hours, he showed us on two occasions the assurance of life after death.

On the first occasion, I went in to say goodbye before I left for work. I asked him he had rested well & he said: "Well yes, but Freda (our sister who passed four weeks prior to Tony's passing) has been sitting right there (pointing to my bookcase) bathing those white swans all night!! " I said "really, all night?" He repeated his response. " Yes, she has been sitting there dressed in all white bathing those white swans."

On the second occasion was another morning when my other brother and I went into my bedroom to visit with our brother and asked how he rested. My brother's response was: "I am very, very tired. Last night Gilbert (our brother who passed away in 1989) wanted to dance on the gold street so we danced all night (my brother Tony was a double amputee) and now both my feet are killing me from dancing all night!" Needless to say, my brother and I just looked at each other across his bed, without a word said we knew our brother was being reassured of a better life after death by our siblings who went before him.

Get In the Boat

Have you ever wondered how to have a one-on-one conversation with God? With no one around. Just you and God? A few years ago, I found a little exercise that I do in my mind to get on-on-one with God. Here is how it works:

Get yourself physically to a quiet place where you are by yourself. The place that you would do your daily devotions is perfect. Open up your Bible to a book you are reading. Close your eyes and slow your mind down. Picture yourself standing on the edge of a huge lake. (My place is the Sea of Galilee in northern Israel). Picture yourself looking at a small wooden boat at the edge of a dock. Walk down to the boat and get in. Just image yourself all alone. The boat has now drifted to the middle of the huge lake. (No paddling required). The lake is about 10 miles across, so you are now all alone in the middle of this lake.

The lake is perfectly calm, just a hint of a breeze. The sun is shining, but not hot. There are no boats, airplanes, birds, or whales anywhere in site. There is a distant ring of clouds that cover the shores in the distance. Those clouds represent the distractions of this life, good and bad. They are in the distance, miles away, so set your mind at ease and let the clouds of this life stay away for a little while. Keep imaging that you are in your small boat, all alone. Really picture the scene, being all alone with nothing, in the middle of the lake. A picture perfect scene. Just you, your boat, and your Bible. Say a short prayer to begin with. Nothing fancy.

Now. Picture that Jesus just sat down in the front of the boat. He is now actively listening to you as you begin to read your Bible. Read as you would normally. Don't try and do anything different. Just read. Don't try and force anything to happen like some great magic show. This is just you reading your Bible with Jesus sitting in the boat. In the middle of the huge lake. With no else around. Don't be surprised if you read a verse and you get the 'feeling' that someone just asked you "what you think of that verse? What does that mean to you? How can you apply that to your life?", etc.

This is something that needs a little practice to get used to. I would suggest that you just practice getting into the boat for a few times before leaving the shore. Today, practice getting in the boat and seeing how it feels. Just sit for a few minutes. Tomorrow, try getting in, sitting for a few minutes, and then get out. That's right, get out. Let your mind drift away (no pun intended) and then go through the process of getting into the boat again. Once you get comfortable with getting in the boat, shove off out to the middle of the lake. Relax and let go! You are about to take off on a voyage that can change your life.

...It changed mine.

*** - The boat and the lake can be changed to whatever vehicle or location that you like. It can be anything from a lawn chair on a porch, a tree stump on a mountain top, a blanket on a beach, to a small chateau overlooking a vineyard in the valley south of Paris.

Update on Chaplain Bob’s Health

Bob & Linda have been active with “**Bill Glass Behind the Walls Ministry**” for the past 18 years. The last 2 years, Bob has been going in as one of the bikers with his 2005 Titan Sidewinder. In 2017 he did **SATF Corcoran Prison** on May 5, **Soledad Prison** on Sept. 23 and **CRC Prison** on Oct. 28, 2017. For 2018. Bob had to cancel Lancaster prison on March 10 and Santa Rita, CA area facilities on March 24 due to weather. Bob will also be participating in the Fresno, Kings and Tulare, CA area on May 4-5, 2018.

The Parkinson’s has become slightly more noticeable and the doctors are surprised how slowly it has gained any ground. (Could it be that your inmate’s prayers for Bob are being heard?) Bob can still predominately stop the shaking in the right hand (only affected area to date).

For the past couple months, Bob’s legs have been swollen and retaining fluid. Aug, 26th Bob finally went to the doctor after his wife, Linda, and mother, Jeanne, were trying to get him to see a doctor. The doctor had some lab tests run and some chest x-rays taken. He then explained that the common cause of the symptoms was congenital heart disease. The doctor scheduled Bob for Monday, August 28th for follow-up, The lab tests came back good – Praise The Lord. Bob was then referred to a cardiologist, where he had an EKG, PET Scan and ultrasound. Bob was scheduled for Sept 26th for follow-up results of these tests.

The results were no heart problems and in fact Bob had a very good heart.

I need to mention that Linda and I have received the BEST MEDICAL CARE I could ask for since we were able to get the military medical coverage since I was in the California Air National Guard for 21 years (Aircraft electrician) and California Army National Guard (Core of engineers and Military academy) for 2 years. Having worked in the medical field for over 20 years, I have seen good care and I have seen bad care. I have been in hospitals that I would not send my dog to. I have seen veterinary facilities that I would rather go to instead of some hospitals, currently we use the *Navel Air Station, Lemoore Hospital* as our primary provider. They are GREAT!!

A quick story of medical service. I had hernia surgery at NASL and took in a large cake for the Doctor and staff. The doctor asked me what it was for? I answered that it was for what he did for me. He replied “*I only did what I was supposed to do.*” I said “*most doctors don’t.*” At a later date my wife, Linda, had a colonoscopy. I brought in another cake. The doctor asked what this cake was for. I replied that any man that was getting that close to my wife either deserved a drink or a cake.

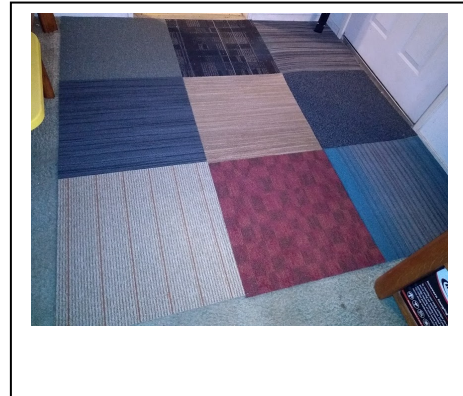

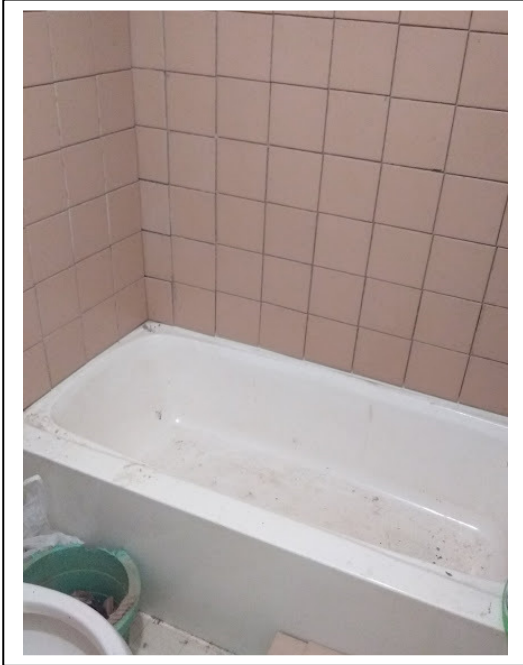

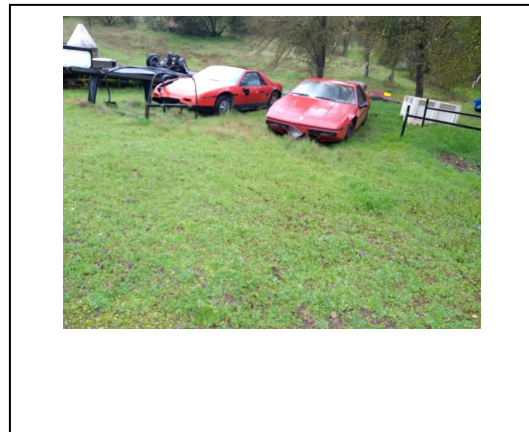

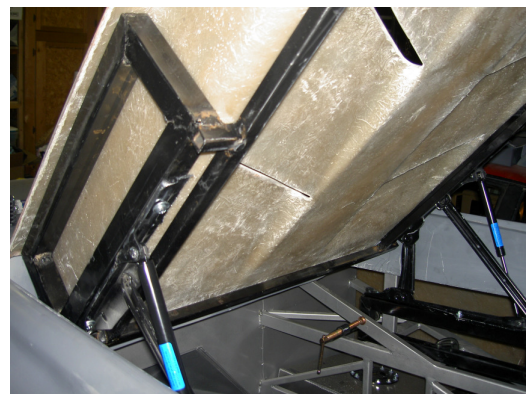

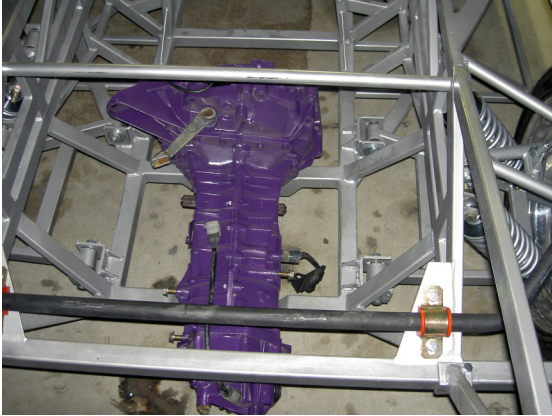

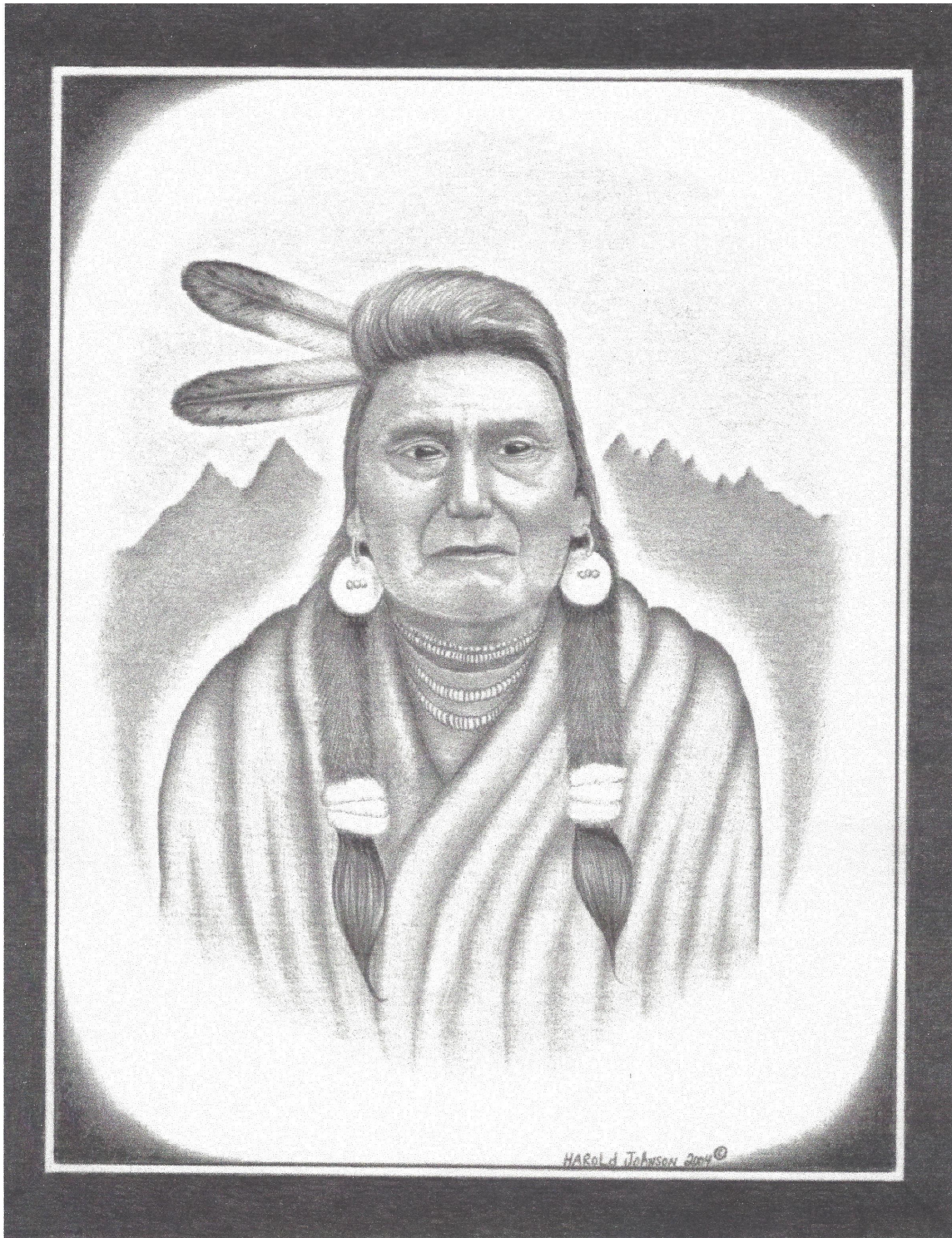

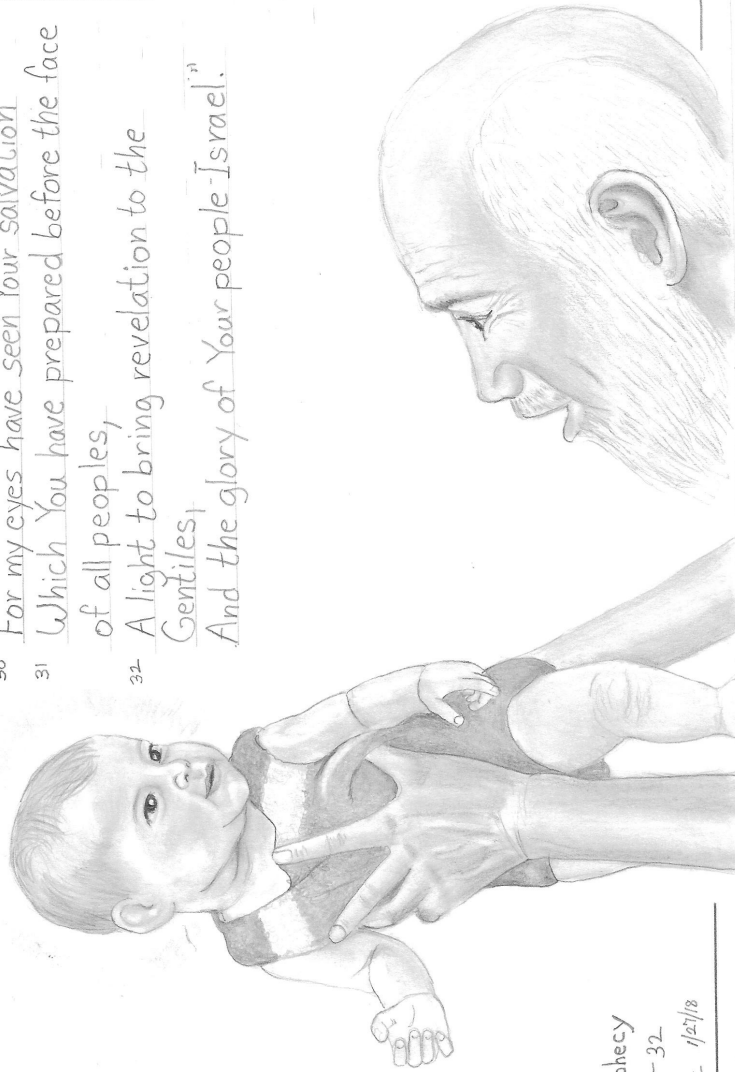
